



The best approach is find yourself on the M4. There are 3 versions outlined below.

From Junction 8/9

If you're coming off at Junction 8/9 you need to head towards Windsor on the A308 (M) for about 600 metres. On the roundabout take the third exit onto the A308. Continue down the A308, you will go under the M4 after 800 metres. Go straight across the mini roundabout and proceed for approximately 1,200 metres and turn right towards Fifiel village. After exiting Fifiel village you will come to a staggered cross junction. Turn right then immediately left. Approximately 600 metres on the left, you will see a sign labelled **PF**. Turn down this track for about 200 metres and you will see the big barn on your left, park up and enter through the small blue door.

From Junction 6 on A308

If you're coming off at Junction 6 you need to head towards Windsor for about 2,000 metres. Take the first exit off this dual carriageway and head for Maidenhead (A308) on the roundabout (3rd exit). Go straight over the next mini roundabout and continue on this 40mph road (a speed camera is positioned 800metres on the left and right of this road), until you come to another roundabout. Go straight across heading towards Maidenhead for approximately 1,200 metres (you should see a Jet garage on the left about 800 metres before the Fifiel village turn. Turn left towards Fifiel village. After exiting Fifiel village you will come to a staggered cross junction. Turn right then immediately left. Approximately 600 metres on the left, you will see a sign labelled **PF**. Turn down this track for about 200 metres and you will see the big barn on your left, park up and enter through the small blue door.

From Junction 6 the scenic route

If you're coming off at Junction 6 you need to head towards Windsor for about 2,000 metres. Take the first exit off this dual carriageway and head for Maidenhead (A308) on the roundabout (3rd exit). If you miss this junction, don't worry, get to the roundabout at the end of the dual carriageway and head for Dedworth (4th exit) and proceed straight over 6 mini roundabouts (Tesco's is on the 5th mini roundabout) for 2 miles until you reach a T-Junction and turn left. (A public house called the Nags Head/Hungry Horse is situated on the left hand side on the corner of this T-Junction). Proceed on this road for about a mile and a half until you reach a staggered cross junction. Turn left and at approximately 600 metres on the left, you will see a sign labelled **PF**. Turn down this track for about 200 metres and you will see the big barn on your left, park up and enter through the small blue door.
